

Steps in getting data from submitters and obtaining further metrics in the Papros site for Third Party Cloud access for Dropbox:

If you do not have one, create a papros account at <https://www.paprosinc.com/login.php>

Then if, you do not have one, create a Dropbox account. Then in Dropbox create a folder (sharing with yourself or anyone you choose) using a name of a single word, however long. For example,

suppliers54

From the Papros site, use the link for “Authorize on Dropbox” from the cloud access link, and follow the steps to do a one-time handshake to authorize access to your dropbox account.

Then on the Papros site, buy at least a midlevel commercial license or higher.

Using the links that allow you, set the remote folder for your dropbox data, using forward slash before and after the name you have set to enter it here. For example, for the above-named folder it would be:

/suppliers54/

Then use the link to let you to be able to create a “persona” in Papros for your Dropbox authorized access so the data can flow directly upon submissions to your Dropbox folder. The “persona” must be of eight or more characters.

Then suppliers can create and upload any set of data and use the window boxes provided to enter your “persona” and submit data directly to your Dropbox folder. For just submission of files, submitters pay nothing. However, if they use any other feature, they may have to obtain licenses based on the feature level. An alternative to this is you to obtain bulk licenses for the submitters to use other features, such as conversion of basic spreadsheet data to a format of your choice. For the latter, contact Papros Inc through the method shown on the site.

At your end, you can obtain further analysis and metrics of the data, including of your entire masterfolders from the third-party cloud access links at the Papros site. Only you will be able to see the data you got. You can also do other data sharing or other operations on Dropbox directly through your Dropbox account.
